- Scores earned after 1/1/98, but before 10/31/08
- Member in good standing when scores were earned
- Rider has never won a Rider Achievement award at this level
- THREE (3) scores with no jumping penalties in cross-country
- 10 or more volunteer hours earned by rider
- Volunteer Hours form submitted along with this form
- All scores earned at USEA-sanctioned competitions with all three phases completed at the competition
- Placed 1st through 6th at one of these competitions
