SERIES DESCRIPTION

This non-competitive program is designed as a combination show and clinic. The objectives are to introduce a rider to dressage showing or help a rider improve his/her show performance. The relaxed, non-competitive atmosphere of the show will also provide participants the opportunity to meet other riders and share experiences.

SERIES FORMAT

Riders are allotted one half hour. The format will be: (1) ride your test and be judged on your ride for a score; (2) be coached by the judge on how to improve your riding of the test; (3) ride the same test and be scored again.

CLASS LIST

CLASS 1 – OPEN CLASS / SELECT ANY TEST: Introductory through Second Level Test 4, plus any USEA 2006 Tests (BN through Training)

- Include level and test in description box on CNYD&CTA Competition Entry Form. Introductory level tests are USDF 2007 editions. Training – Second level tests are USEF 2007 editions. *Note: some locations use a small arena.

ENTRIES

Members: \$30 per session *Non-members:* \$40 per session

Secretary / Office Fee: \$10 for each rider / horse combination entered

- Include a current Negative Coggins test or previous year (if tested within NYS), and a current rabies certificate with entry.
- Entries are limited. Preference given to CNYD&CTA members. If the show is oversubscribed a waiting list will be established.
- Entries processed in order received by the post-marked "opening date" up to the post-marked "closing date".
- Incomplete entries will not be processed until complete.
- Refunds: less \$10 office fee, refunds after the closing dates are only available with medical certificate (horse or rider) received within 7 days of the show date.
- Use the CNYD&CTA Competition Entry form located in the back of this Omnibus or available at www.cnydcta.org.
- Send entry to show secretary. Make checks payable to CNYD&CTA.
- Scores **will not** count towards CNYD&CTA Year End Awards.

TIMES & DIRECTIONS

Times mailed to those who include a self-addressed stamped envelope with entry. Times are posted at location the day before the show.

Directions are posted on the web site, www.cnydcta.org. **No dogs allowed.**

ARENA & FOOTING

Greyrock Farm – the show will be held in an indoor, small sand arena. Warm-up in an outdoor grass arena.

Stonebreaker Ridge – the show will be held in an outdoor, large sand arena. Warm-up on outdoor grass or indoor sand arena.
