SERIES DESCRIPTION

CNYD&CTA is pleased to present periodic Dressage clinics with Bill McMullin in 2009. An USDF Certified Instructor through 4th level, who was enthusiastically received by CNYD&CTA's 2005 Adult Dressage Camp, Bill is an articulate instructor who melds exercises into all levels to produce great rider/horse improvement. He has been involved in the USDF Instructor Certification program for 13 years and is a USEF "r" Dressage Judge and USDF Silver Medalist. Bill judges, instructs and is currently training with Betsy Steiner to compete at 3rd level this season.

ENTRIES: *Private (45 minutes): \$120 members / \$145 non-members (per each private lesson)*

- Include a current Negative Coggins test or previous year (if tested within NYS), and a current rabies certificate with entry.
- Entries are limited. Preference given to riders who ride both days and CNYD&CTA members w/in first 10 days after opening date.
- If there are multiple acceptable entries, riders will be drawn by lottery.
- Entries processed in order received by the post-marked "opening date" date up to the post-marked "closing date".
- NO REFUNDS. If there are insufficient entries and the clinic is cancelled, monies collected will be refunded.
- Times will be posted on www.cnydcta.org or by contacting the secretary. Refer to CNYD&CTA's newsletter or website for updates.
