IMPORTANT NOTES ABOUT CLASSES

- **Jr/YR (Junior/Young Rider), AA (Adult Amateur), Open** – Classes will be held concurrently with open classes, but will be pinned as separate divisions. You must state the division in which you will compete on the entry form. If not specified, open will be assumed. As per the secretary's discretion, class divisions may be combined if entries are low.
- **Combined Test Dressage classes will run first thing in the morning.**

AWARDS

Six ribbons for each class. Classes 1-11 will count towards year-end awards.

ENTRIES

Class 1-11: members \$12 / non-members \$15

Class 12-14: members \$15 / non-members \$18

Secretary / Office Fee: \$10 for each rider / horse combination entered

- Un-scored second jump rounds available at each level for \$10/round – post entries allowed.
- Include a current Negative Coggins test or previous year (if tested within NYS), and a current rabies certificate with entry.
- Entries are limited. Preference given to CNYD&CTA members. If the show is oversubscribed a waiting list will be established.
- Entries processed in order received by the postmarked "opening date" up to the post-marked "closing date".
- Incomplete entries will not be processed until complete.
- Refunds: less \$10 office fee, refunds after the closing dates are only available with medical certificate (horse or rider) received within 7 days of the show date.
- Use the CNYD&CTA Competition Entry form located in this Omnibus or available at www.cnydcta.org.
- Send entry to show secretary. Make checks payable to CNYD&CTA.

ARENAS AND FOOTING

All dressage classes will be held in an outdoor sand arena, warm-up in an indoor rubber arena. Jumping classes on grass. Longeing only permitted when not interfering with mounted riders.
