#### **SERIES DESCRIPTION**

CNYD&CTA is pleased to present periodic Eventing clinics with Carol Kozlowski in 2009. Carol is a nationally known rider, instructor and coach. A graduate "A" Pony Clubber, she is based out of her farm "Mothersfield" in Avon, NY. She has been an active competitor for over 25 years, riding through the CCI3\* level. She has coached the successful Area II Young Riders Teams from 2004-06. Carol works daily with all levels of horses and riders, from breaking youngsters to coaching at the top levels.

#### **SERIES FORMAT**

Participants can select instruction in dressage, stadium jumping and / or cross country (not available at all locations).

#### **ENTRIES**

**Private (45 minutes):** \$85 members / \$95 non-members

**Semi-Private (2 riders, 1 hour):** \$65 members / \$75 non-members

**Group (3 riders, 1 hour):** \$50 members / \$60 non-members

- Participants must pay in advance (no later than 10 days prior to clinic).
- Use the CNYD&CTA Clinic Entry form located in the Omnibus or available from [www.cnydcta.org](http://www.cnydcta.org).
- Negative Coggins dated current or previous year (if NYS), and a current rabies certificate must be submitted with entry.
- Mail clinic entry and check, made payable to CNYD&CTA, to manager/secretary.
- Entries are limited. Preference given to CNYD&CTA members. If the clinic is oversubscribed, a waiting list will be established.
- Refunds: **NO REFUNDS!** If there are insufficient entries and the clinic is cancelled, collected fees will be refunded.

#### **ATTIRE**

Clinic attire is requested (boots, breeches or jodhpurs, gloves, polo shirt). ASTM/ SEI approved helmet is required. Medical Armband and X-C Safety Vest are strongly recommended for cross-country instruction.
