IMPORTANT NOTES ABOUT CLASSES

- **Jr/YR (Junior/Young Rider), AA (Adult Amateur), Open** – Classes will be held concurrently with Open classes, but will be pinned as separate divisions. You must state the division in which you will compete on the entry form. If not specified, Open will be assumed. As per the secretary's discretion, class divisions may be combined if entries are low.

AWARDS

Six ribbons for each class. Champion and Reserve Champion awarded at each of the following levels: Introductory, Training, First, Second, Third, Fourth for Jr/YR, Adult Amateur, and Open. A rider/horse combination may win only one Champion or Reserve ribbon, which will be at the highest level in which they compete. USEA tests **will not** count towards Championship. Classes 16-18 **do not** count towards CNYD&CTA Year End Awards. Awards may be combined if entries are low.

ENTRIES

Class 1-18: members \$17.50 / non-members \$25.00

Class 19: members \$22.50 / non-members \$33.00

Class 20: members \$12.50 / non-members \$20.00

Secretary / Office Fee: \$10 for each rider / horse combination entered

- Include a current Negative Coggins test or previous year (if tested within NYS), and a current rabies certificate with entry.
- Entries are limited. Preference given to CNYD&CTA members. If the show is oversubscribed a waiting list will be established.
- Entries processed in order received by the post-marked "opening date" up to the post-marked "closing date".
- Incomplete entries will not be processed until complete.
- Refunds: less \$10 office fee, refunds after the closing dates are only available with medical certificate (horse or rider) received within 7 days of the show date.
- Musical Freestyle Rides: an audiotape or CD of music plus instructions must be supplied to the secretary at least 2 hours before class.
- Hors de Concours Rides: will be accepted, space permitting, and must be indicated on the entry form.
- Use the CNYD&CTA Competition Entry form located in the back of this Omnibus or available at www.cnydcta.org.
- Send entry to show secretary. Make checks payable to CNYD&CTA.
