WHAT IS AN INFORMAL?

An "Informal" is an educational, relaxed and fun dressage schooling show. Riders show in polo shirts and are scored by an "L" graduate judge.

WHY RIDE IN AN INFORMAL?

- You may perform the same test more than once.
- You may pick up your test as soon as it's scored.
- You can ride and pick up volunteer hours on the very same day!
- The secretary will try to work with your schedule if you'd like to ride early or late, back to back tests, etc.
- It's STRESS-FREE and FUN!

CLASS LIST

CLASS 1 – OPEN CLASS / SELECT ANY TEST:

- USDF Introductory & USEF Training - 2nd Level (2007 tests)
- USEF Beginner Novice A&B, Novice A&B and Training A&B (2006 tests)
- Include level and test in description box on CNYD&CTA Competition Entry Form.

ENTRIES

Members: \$10 per test

Non-members: \$15 per test

Secretary / Office Fee: \$10 for each rider / horse combination entered

- Include a Negative Coggins test date current or previous year (if tested within NYS), and a current rabies certificate with entry.
- Refunds: less \$10 office fee, refunds after closing date are only available with medical certificate (horse or rider) received within 7 days of the show date.
- Use the CNYD&CTA Competition Entry form located in this Omnibus or available at www.cnydcta.org.
- Send entry to show secretary. Make checks payable to CNYD&CTA.

SCORING

Scores **will not** count towards CNYD&CTA year end awards.

ARENAS & FOOTING

Standard sand arena, warm-up is on stone dust. Longeing only permitted if not interfering with mounted riders.

ATTIRE

Clinic attire is requested (boots, breeches or jodhpurs, gloves, polo shirt). ASTM/ SEI approved helmet is required.
