

SCORING A DRESSAGE TEST IN COMBINED TRAINING

+	maximum possible points	NOTE 1
-	total "good" points	NOTE 2

=	difference	
X	multiply by 0.5	

=	penalty score	
+	error points	NOTE 3

=	final penalty score	NOTE 4

NOTE 1: **Maximum possible points:** (found on test sheet)

NOTE 2: **"Good Points"** are the total of points awarded by the Judge

NOTE 3:

Error Points for 1 st error	=	2
Error Points for 2 nd error	=	4
Error Points for 3 rd error	=	8
Error Points for 4 th error	=	elimination

NOTE 4: When scoring a dressage test ridden in the Combined Test Division - - - **errors are positive numbers and are added to the penalty score to calculate the final penalty score.**

NOTE 5: The lowest final penalty score wins. Ties can occur, if there is a tie, 2 ribbons are awarded for the same place and no places are skipped.
