WHAT is a Show-&-Tell?

- Ride your dressage test, followed by a 15-minute lesson from the judge. After the lesson, you'll ride your test again, incorporating the judge's feedback. Both tests will be scored and the results will be handed to you.

ENTRIES:

- Any single horse and rider combination can ride in up to 2 rides
- Any single horse with multiple riders can do up to 4 rides
- All entries must include proof of a Negative Coggins test within 12-months of the show (if tested within NYS), and a current rabies certificate.
- Refunds: may be given prior to the closing date minus the \$15 office fee. Refunds after the closing date may be given with proof of a medical certificate (horse or rider), which must be received by management within 7 days of the show date.
- Use the CNYD&CTA Competition Entry form available at www.cnydcta.org.
- All horses (competing & non-competing) must wear assigned number at all times while on show grounds; all riders (competing & non-competing) are required to wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets.
- Space is limited. Preference will be given to CNYD&CTA members and completed entries. Entries are not considered complete if any of the above information is missing. If the show is oversubscribed a waiting list will be established.

- Entries are processed in order received by the post-marked “opening date” up to the post-marked “closing date”.
- USDF Tests are from 2023 and USEA Tests are from 2026.
- Musical Freestyle Rides: an audiotape or CD of music plus instructions must be supplied to the secretary at least 2 hours before class.

- Times will be posted at www.cnydcta.org

AWARDS:

- No awards are awarded for this event. The first test can be used toward the CNYDCTA year-end awards.

SCORES:

- Results will be posted on cnydcta.org following the show.
- The first text scores earned may be submitted for Jr/YR, AA, and Open divisions for the CNYD&CTA Schooling Show Year End Awards, including Western Dressage. See cnydcta.org for more information.

ATTIRE:

- Boots, breeches or jodhpurs, gloves, polo/show shirts, show jackets requested
- All riders must wear ASTM/ SEI approved helmet (including Western & non-competing riders).
- USEF/USEA Dressage rules regarding bits, tack, and equipment will be in effect for all classes.

ARENAS & FOOTING:

- Competition Ring: outdoor sand arena; in case of inclement weather or to accommodate the show schedule, classes may be held in the indoor sand arena (at discretion of management).
- Warm-up: outdoor stone dust arena
- Lunging may be permitted if not interfering with mounted riders; please check with management before lunging.

STABLING:

- No on-site stabling is available
