Volunteer Opportunities at CNYD&CTA Shows and Clinics

- Ring Set Up: Typically the Friday or Saturday before the show date, multiple volunteers needed
- Ring Break Down: Pickup arena and clean up (at end of show), multiple volunteers needed
- Jump Set Up: Typically the Friday or Saturday before the show date, multiple volunteers needed
- Jump Break Down: Clean up and put away jumps (at end of show), multiple volunteers needed
- Greeter: Hands out numbers to competitor, help direct people where to find bathrooms, water, etc., may be AM/PM shifts
- Scribe: The judge is assisted by a scribe, who writes the judge's scores and comments on the score sheet. The comments are meant to help the rider understand each of the individual scores. This is a GREAT opportunity to learn more about what judges are looking for, may be AM/PM shifts

- Runner: Transfers test from scribe to scorer, allows you to watch tests, may be AM/PM shifts
- Scorer: Tallies up the coefficients and score the test, records the scores on the board, assists show secretary, may be AM/PM shifts

- Ring Steward: Keeps the show flowing smoothly – makes sure riders are present in warm up ring, wearing their numbers, and approved tack/attire, keeps the show running on time, may be AM/PM shifts
