FEES:

Class 1-14, 16-20: Members \$30.00 / Non-Members \$40.00

Class 15 - USDF Musical Freestyle: Members \$35.00 / Non-Members \$45.00

Class 21 - Dressage Seat Equitation: Members \$15.00 / Non-Members \$25.00

Class 22 - Leadline: \$15.00 per rider. *Secretary Fee is waived for this class only*

Non-competing horses: \$15 day fee plus Secretary Fee

Secretary / Office Fee: \$15 for each horse / rider combination entered

ENTRIES:

- Any single horse and rider combination can ride in up to 4 classes
- Any single horse with multiple riders can do up to 5 classes
- All entries must include proof of a Negative Coggins test within 12-months of the show (if tested within NYS), a current rabies certificate, and a flu/rhino vaccine within 6-months of show date.
- Refunds may be granted if notice given by the Close Date, minus a \$15 Office Fee. Scratches must be received by email to Show Manager by day of show and refunds after the Close Date may be granted with proof of a medical certificate (horse or rider), which must be received by the Show Manager within 7 days of the Show Date.
- All horses (competing & non-competing) must wear assigned number at all times while on show grounds; all riders (competing & non-competing) are required to wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets.
- Space is limited. Preference will be given to CNYD&CTA members and completed entries. Entries are not considered complete if any of the above information is missing. If the show is oversubscribed a waiting list will be established.
- Entries are processed in order received by the post-marked "opening date" up to the post-marked "closing date".
- USDF Tests are from 2023 and USEA Tests are from 2026.

- Musical Freestyle Rides: an audiotape or CD of music plus instructions must be supplied to the secretary at least 2 hours before class.
- **NO DOGS ALLOWED**

TIMES:

- Times will be posted at www.cnydcta.org
- Class 22- Leadline will be held at the earliest convenience (generally mid-day or lunch time)

AWARDS:

- Classes will be held concurrently and will be placed as such. Please mark your division on the entry form. If not specified, competitors will be placed in the Open division. Ribbons will be combined for Jr/YR, AA and Open if entries are low per class, or separated if warranted
- One Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons will be awarded for the highest scoring Jr/YR, Adult Amateur, and Open division of the day. A rider/horse combination may win only one Champion or Reserve ribbon. Classes 1-3, and 14-22 do not count towards high point of the day. Riders must be present to receive any and all awards. Awards may be combined if entries are low.

SCORES:

- Results will be posted on cnydcta.org following the show.
- Scores earned may be submitted for Jr/YR, AA, and Open divisions for the CNYD&CTA Schooling Show Year End Awards, including Western Dressage. See cnydcta.org for more information.

ATTIRE:

- Boots, breeches or jodhpurs, gloves, polo/show shirts, show jackets requested
- All riders must wear ASTM/ SEI approved helmet (including Western & non-competing riders).
- USEF/USEA Dressage rules regarding bits, tack, and equipment will be in effect for all classes.

ARENAS & FOOTING:

- Competition Ring: outdoor sand arena; in case of inclement weather or to accommodate the show schedule, classes may be held in the indoor sand arena (at discretion of management).
- Warm-up: outdoor stone dust arena
- Lunging may be permitted if not interfering with mounted riders; please check with management before lunging.

STABLING:

- No on-site stabling is available
